

ACTING FOR FILM, TV AND THE THEATRE

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

Live auditions for prospective students are held at **Dundas Campus**:

Toronto Film School at RCC Institute of Technology 10 Dundas St. E Floor 7 Toronto, ON M5B 2G9

Requirements:

- 1. A brief interview with the coordinators/faculty
- 2. 1-2 minute monologue from a play /movie
- 3. You will be asked to cold read a script
- 4. A photograph
- 5. An acting resume if available OR a paragraph on why you want to be an actor

**For those who are unable to attend a live audition due to proximity to the school (must be outside of the GTA), we will accept applications in the following format:

- 1. 1 page essay on "What inspired you to be an actor?"
- 2. A video submission that includes:
 - 1-2 minutes explaining why you want to be an actor
 - 1-2 minutes of a monologue from a play/ movie

Please submit the videos by uploading them to a Youtube/Vimeo link and emailing it to us or mail a DVD

3. Please email a snapshot of yourself

Video Submission Criteria

- Ensure you are front lit, NOT back lit.
- Make sure the volume is up.
- Camera should be 8-10 feet away from you.
- Email a YouTube/Vimeo or mail a DVD.
